



Classic and Contented.


There's a timeless charm to the palette of Felicity, made of colours that have endured over a long period of time yet unwaveringly appeal to us. Classic colours like **Mulethi Roots-N** and **Green Ebony** that have a dense and absorbing quality are balanced by pale dyelike natural colours, giving the palette a sense of contentment and restfulness. The muted grey-blue of **Dolphin Dance**, soft **Pinkish Beige-N** and airy **Ethereal Sage-N** are inspired by mid-century graphics and patterns. The calm white of **Soft Silk** holds the palette together.

The material palette for Felicity consists of materials that are long-lasting and have an emotional durability to them. **Organic Linen,** a timetested earth-friendly material is ideal for upholstery and furnishings in living spaces. Durable and elegant **Eri Silk,** found traditionally in Assam and also known as Ahimsa silk adds a vintage charm when used in moderation. **Stainless Steel** and **Terracotta,** both ordinary materials made extraordinary through contemporary usage have endured centuries in Indian homes and appeal to our senses even today. **Gokul Pichwai** from **Nilaya Sabyasachi III** reminds one of the vibrant miniature painting of medieval India, contrasted by pearlescent **Apex Ultima Allura Animamundi,** a washed-out concrete finish reinterpreting a timeless modernist aesthetic.






Elegant openings allow light to pour into a space, filling it with a sense of wellbeing.

Architectural elements like steps and staircases create moments of pause, rhythm and a natural flow.







A place layered with memories and collectibles, homes celebrate the anecdotes, choices and details that often last a lifetime.




Paired with lush colours, the relaxed vibe of cane chairs helps one ease in and feel at home.


